Unama'ki, Cape Breton Island, is located in Mi'kma'ki - the ancestral and unceded territory of the Mi'kmaw people.

The territory includes Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Newfoundland, parts of the Gaspé Peninsula, and Maine.

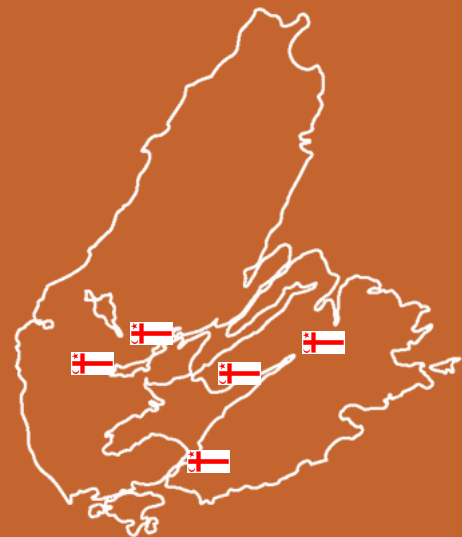
